The Hall of Breeds will be a display of a variety of wool and meat breeds of sheep. The following guidelines and information are available for those breeders wishing to exhibit in the Hall of Breeds at the 14th Annual Iowa Sheep & Wool Festival.

- The Festival will provide one pen free of charge per breed. Also a tack area will be provided for hay and feed storage.
- Up to six sheep per pen will be allowed.
- The Festival will provide the sign describing the breed. The exhibitor may hang signs with contact information and stock for sale.
- Private treaty sales of sheep entered in the Hall of Breeds will be allowed, **but at least two sheep must remain in the display until the end of the festival on Sunday.**
- Any shearing must be done prior to arrival at the Hansen Ag Learning Center. Sheep should be reasonably clean with no manure tags. We are representing the sheep industry, so it is important to make the best impression possible to the public.
- For protection of all livestock at the festival, we will follow the rules set forth by the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship “*Health Requirements For Exhibition of Livestock, Poultry and Birds at State Fair and District Shows*” which can be found at: <http://www.iowaagriculture.gov/animalIndustry.asp>.
- A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must have been issued within 14 days prior to the date of entry to the Festival and will be required at arrival on the fairgrounds. Health papers and sheep are subject to inspection by a veterinarian upon arrival.
- All sexually intact sheep must be identified with an individual scrapie flock of origin identification tag and this number must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
- All livestock exhibitors are **expected** to clean up their pens and move bedding to designated area. In the past, exhibitors have worked together to help clean up their areas which has made the cleaning process go very smoothly. We encourage all exhibitors to do this, if possible.
- Exhibitors may set-up Friday, June 15, 2018 from 3 pm-7 pm. Must be set up by 7:30 am on Sat., June 16, 2018.
- Hall of Breeds exhibitors will receive free admission for two people to the festival for both days.

Only one pen will be provided free of charge for each breed in the Hall of Breeds and ***the first EXHIBITOR to request a specific breed will be honored. It is necessary to Contact JASON SEELOW, Hall of Breeds Chair, at 641-751-0530 or email JRSEELO@GMAIL.COM to secure free pens for the Hall of Breeds.*** Once space is secured, exhibitor must fill out the form on following page and mail to Jason Seelow, Hall of Breeds Chair, at the address on form.
